Metal Roof Guidelines

The Following will serve as the guidelines for residents when seeking approval for Standing seam metal roofs within Lakefield West.

- Roof material should be Galvaume or similar coated steel panels.
- Metal thickness should be 24 gauge (which is optimal) or 22 gauge.
- Standing Seams should be 16 inches apart.
- Standing Seams should be 1 and a half inches in height.
- Rubberized or similar underlayment must be installed between wooden roof decking and metal panels to act as a moisture barrier, as required by code. This may provide some sound deafening reduction as well.
- Shiny, metallic and other highly reflective colors shall be avoided.
- Metal panels should include Striations for strength and aid in eliminating the wavy (oil canning) look which may be seen in flat panels
- Attic fans, solar or other must meet Wellington code, and are up to the Homeowner.
- Roof color must be approved by the A.R.C. prior to the roof being installed. Submit your color choice to the A.R.C. for review before work is started.
